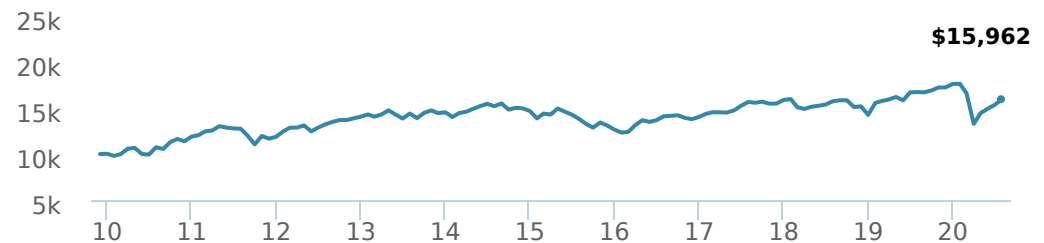

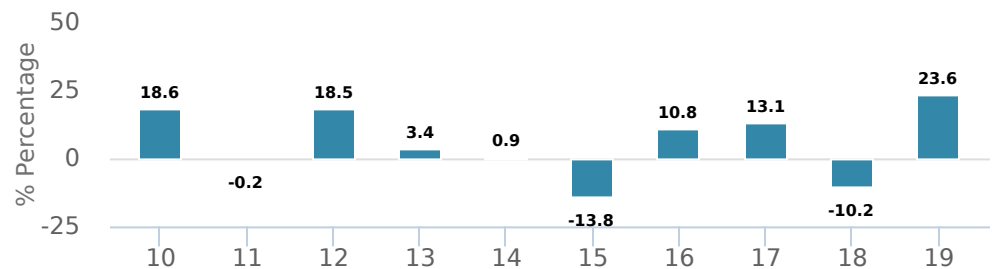

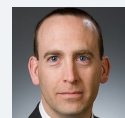
## MANAGEMENT TEAM
